The City of Brookings ordains as follows:

Section 1. Proceedings for vacation of unnamed alley. The council, having made its own motion to vacate the hereinafter described portion of alley and having directed the giving of notice required by law and having held the public hearing called for by said notice, finds, and hereby makes its determination a matter of record, that the proceedings for the vacation of said portion of alley were had upon the council's own motion and not upon petition; that the notice required by law was duly and regularly given; that the public interest will not be prejudiced by the vacating of said portion of alley but on the contrary the best interest and welfare of the public will be served by such vacating and such vacation should be effected.

Section 2. Property description. Of that certain unnamed alley which exists between Block B and Block 12 as the same was platted and appears of record upon that certain map entitled Plat No. 1, Brookings, Curry County, Oregon, which was approved and filed December 1, 1920, in Book 1, Page 5, Official Record of Town Plants, Curry County, Oregon, the hereinafter described portion should be and is hereby vacated absolutely, leaving the public with no right or interest whatsoever therein. The port of said alley so vacated is thus described:
