

ORDINANCE NO. 54-O-053

**AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF MYRTLE STREET AND A PORTION OF AN ALLEY, LOCATION IN BLOCK 30, AS SAME WAS PLATTED AND SHOWN UPON MAP ENTITLED "PLAT NO. 1, BROOKINGS, CURRY COUNTY, OREGON" APPROVED AND RECORDED DECEMBER 1, 1920, IN BOOK 1, PAGE 5, OFFICIAL RECORD OF TOWN PLATS, CURRY COUNTY, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Brookings ordains as follows:

Section 1. Proceedings for vacation of unnamed alley. The council, having made its own motion to vacate the hereinafter described portion of alley and having directed the giving of notice required by law and having held the public hearing called for by said notice, finds, and hereby makes its determination a matter of record, that the proceedings for the vacation of said portion of alley were had upon the council's own motion and upon petition of the United States of America, by H.O. Obye, Supervisor Siskiyou National Forest, United States Department of Agriculture; that the notice required by law was duly and regularly given; that the public interest will not be prejudiced by the vacating of said portion of alley but on the contrary the best interest and welfare of the public will be served by such vacating and such vacation should be effected.

Section 2. Vacation of portion of Myrtle Street between southerly boundary of Redwood Street and Northerly boundary of Oregon Coast Highway. Of that portion of Myrtle Street of the City of Brookings which exists and extends from and between the Southerly boundary line of Redwood Street and the Northerly boundary line of the Oregon Coast Highway should be, and hereby is, declared vacated absolutely, leaving the public with no right or interest whatsoever therein and this said portion of said Myrtle Street shall revert back to the abutting property owners, of said vacated portion , as provided by law.

Section 3. Vacation of certain unnamed alley from Westerly boundary of Myrtle Street to Easterly boundary of Alder Street. Of that certain unnamed alley which exists in Block 30 and extends from the Westerly boundary line of Myrtle Street to the Easterly boundary line of Alder Street should be, and hereby is, declared vacated absolutely, leaving the public with no right or interest whatsoever therein and this said portion of said unnamed alley shall revert back to the abutting property owners, of said vacated portion, as provided by law.

Section 4. Property description. For a further and better description of the said Myrtle Street and unnamed alley and the aforesaid Block 30, the same are declared to be the Myrtle Street and unnamed alley located in Block 30, as the same was platted and appears of record upon that certain map entitled Plat No. 1, Brookings, Curry County, Oregon, which was approved and filed December 1, 1920, in Book 1, Page 5, Official Record of Town Plants, Curry County, Oregon.

Section 5. Recordation. The City Engineer shall cause to be recorded with the Recorder of Curry County, Oregon, the map which was prepared by the City Engineer showing and setting forth that portion of Myrtle Street and that portion of the unnamed alley hereby, in this ordinance, vacated.

Section 6. [Emergency clause]

Effective January 12, 1954
