WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Brookings, Oregon, has determined that a new tax base should be established as authorized by subsection (2), section 11 Article XI, Oregon Constitution, in order to permit the proper operation of the city affairs within the limitation contained in section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to submit the question of establishing a new tax base to the legal voters of the City of Brookings, Oregon,

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BROOKINGS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Submission of proposition. The proposition set forth in section 2 of this ordinance shall be submitted in the manner prescribed in this ordinance to the legal voters of the City of Brookings, Oregon, at a city tax base election to be held on November 2, 1954 at the same time and in the same place of the holding of the regular general election.

Section 2. Ballot title. At the city tax base election there shall be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Brookings, Oregon, for their approval or rejection, the following proposition:

Shall the City of Brookings, Oregon, Curry County, State of Oregon, increase its tax base from \$ 21,125.85 (the present base in dollars and cents) to \$29,250.00 (the proposed base in dollars and cents)

Section 3. Date of election. There is a state-wide regular election being held in the State Of Oregon and in the City of Brookings, on November 2nd, 1954, and this city tax base election is called to be held concurrently therewith, and as a part thereof.

Section 4. Polling places. (1) the regular polling places designated by the County Court of Curry County Oregon, in the voting precincts in the City of Brookings hereby are designated as the polling places for the city tax base election; the poll books adopted by the County Court of Curry County Oregon as the poll books for the state-wide regular election for the voting precincts in the city of Brookings hereby are adopted as the poll books to the extent that the same contain the names of electors who qualify as legal electors to vote upon city of Brookings propositions and strictly as, the said electors are residents of the City of Brookings and qualify under the provisions of the Charter of the City of Brookings as city electors, for the city tax base election; and the judges and clerks of election appointed by the County Court of Curry County, Oregon, to serve at the state-wide regular general election hereby are designated as the judges and clerks of and for the city tax base election.

(2) The judges and clerks shall hold their respective offices as designated for the state-wide regular general election.

(3) The polls for the city tax base election shall be open in each of the voting precincts at the same hour, and shall be kept open until the same hour, as the polls are opened and closed for the state-wide regular general election that will be held on the same day.

Section 5. Publication notice form. Notice of the city tax base election shall be given not earlier than twenty (20) days and not later than ten (10) days before the election, said notice shall issue under the seal of the city and the notice of the city tax base election shall (a) be published in two (2) consecutive issues of the Brookings Harbor Pilot, a newspaper of general circulation in the city of Brookings, Oregon and (b) posted in five (5) public places in the city of Brookings, Oregon including the city hall. The notice published in the newspaper and posted in five (5) public places shall be in the following form:

Section 6. Posting of election notices. The City Recorder shall advertise and post or cause to be posted the notices required by section 5 of this ordinance. The notices of the city tax base election required to be given by section 5 of this ordinance shall constitute the only notice necessary and all ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith shall not apply to the notices required to be given of this election. It shall be unnecessary for either the City of Brookings or any officials thereof to furnish the legal voters at the city tax base election pamphlets containing either (a) the text of the proposition, or (b) arguments in support of or in opposition to the proposition.

Section 7. Form of printed ballots. The following is the number and form in which the question shall be printed on the official ballots:

Section 8. Printing and distribution of official ballots. The City Recorder shall provide for the printing of the official ballot provided for in Section 7 of this ordinance and provide for the proper distribution thereof and shall provide and furnish to the polling places and judges and clerks of election, as said polling places and judges and clerks are set forth and named in section 4 of this ordinance, all necessary materials as the same may be required in said polling places and by said judges and clerks and so be necessary in the holding of this city tax base election.
