WHEREAS, the regularly appointed and acting budget committee of the City of Brookings has, in accordance with the provisions of the Local Budget Law (Paragraph ORS 294305 - 294415) as of date of may 11, 1955, prepared and adopted their budget for the City of Brookings for said fiscal year, this said budget and the estimates thereof having been approved on June 8, 1955, by the City Council, the levying board for the City of Brokings, Oregon, after a lawful hearing thereon having been held, and so having been adlopted to the effect aht in addition to the amount of \$29,350.00, there shallb e raised by direct lvey upon taxable property within teh corporate limits of the City of Brookings the additional sum of \$11,958.00, which sum is outside the limitation on taxation set forth in Article XI, Oregon Constitution, and whereas it is necessary to submit the question of the levy of the said sum of to the legal voters of the City of Brookings, Oregon.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BROOKINGS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Submission of proposition. The proposition set forth in section 2 of this ordinance shall be submitted in the manner prescribed in this ordinance to the legal voters of the City of Brookings, Oregon, at a special city election to be held on July 7, 1955.

Section 2. Ballot title. At the aforesaid special election there shall be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Brookings, Oregon, for their approval or rejection, the following proposition:

"In the fiscal period of 1955-56 the Council of the City of Brookings, Curry County, Oregon, Oregon, is authorized to levy a tax of \$11,958.00 for the purpose of balancing the budget for said fiscal period which tax is to be outside the limitation on taxation set forth in Article XI, Section 11, of the Constitution of Oregon."

Section 3. Polling places. (1) The polling place for the aforesaid special election shall be in the Council Chambers of the City Hall of the City of Brookings, Oregon and the polls for this special city election shall be open between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., of the date on which the said special election shall be held.

(2) The judges for the aforesaid election shall be Max Brainard, Gladys Kanick and Virginia Manley, and the clerks thereof shall be Elsa Raveckes, Verna Mendenhall and Priscilla Robinson and the said judges and clerks shall hold their respective offices as so designated during the day of the said special election.

Section 4. Publication notice form. Notice of the city tax base election shall be given not earlier than twenty (20) days and not later than ten (10) days before the election, said notice shall issue under the seal of the city and the notice of the city tax base election shall (a) be published in two (2) consecutive issues of the Brookings Harbor Pilot, a newspaper of general circulation in the city of Brookings, Oregon and (b) posted in five (5) public places in the city of Brookings, Oregon including the city hall. The notice published in the newspaper and posted in five (5) public places shall be in the following form:

Section 5. Posting of election notices. The City Recorder shall advertise and post or cause to be posted the notices required by section 5 of this ordinance. The notices of the city tax base election required to be given by section 5 of this ordinance shall constitute the only notice necessary and all ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith shall not apply to the notices required to be given of this election. It shall be unnecessary for either the City of Brookings or any officials thereof to furnish the legal voters at the city tax base election pamphlets containing either (1) the text of the proposition, or (2) arguments in support of or in opposition to the proposition.

Section 6. Form of printed ballots. The following is the number and form in which the question shall be printed on the official ballots:

Section 7. Printing and distribution of official ballots. The City Recorder shall provide for the printing of the official ballot provided for in Section 7 of this ordinance and provide for the proper distribution thereof and shall provide and furnish to the polling places and judges and clerks of election, as said polling places and judges and clerks are set forth and named in section 4 of this ordinance, all necessary materials as the same may be required in said polling places and by said judges and clerks and so be necessary in the holding of this special city election.
