The City of Brookings does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Definitions. The term " Agreement" as hereinafter used in this ordinance shall mean that certain written agreement, executed August 16th, 1955 by and between the State of Oregon, by and through its State Highway Commission, and the City of Brookings, Oregon, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, by and through its City Councils A copy of said written agreement is attached hereto and by such reference made a part of this ordinance

Section 2. Declaration of intent. It is hereby declared that it is the intention of the City Council, upon behalf of the City of Brookings, to enter into and be bound by the specific agreement involved*

Section 3. Authorization to execute "Agreement". It shall be the duty of the Mayor, together with the City Recorder, to execute said agreement as of August 16th, 1955 and the said Mayor and City Recorder are hereby authorized and empowered so to execute said agreements and to bind the City of Brookings to the terms, agreements, conditions and provisions as each and all thereof are contained and included in said agreement.
