The City of Brookings ordains as follows:

Section 1. Definition. The term "Permit" as hereinafter used in this ordinance shall mean that permit applied for in an application to the State of Oregon, by and through its State Engineer, to appropriate certain Public Waters of the State of Oregon for use as a Municipal Water Supply by the City of Brookings, Oregon, a copy of said application being attached to this ordinance and by such reference made a part of this ordinance.

Section 2. Declaration of intention to file application. It is hereby declared that it is the intention of the City Council, upon behalf of the City of Brookings, to enter into and be bound by the agreements, provisions and conditions set forth and included in the written application for said permit.

Section 3. Execution of application. It shall be the duty of the Mayor, together with the City Recorder, to execute said application for said permit as of August 25, 1955, and the Mayor and Recorder are hereby authorized and empowered so to execute said application for said permit, and, further, by said execution to bind the City of Brookings to each and all of the agreements, provisions and conditions contained and set forth in said application for permit and in the copy thereof which is attached to and made a part of this ordinance.
