AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CALLING OF A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, OREGON, ON JANUARY 20, 1956; FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY THE QUESTIONS OF APPROVING OR REJECTING THE ACQUISITION AND CONSTRUCTION OF A SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY AND THE APPROVAL OR REJECTION OF A GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND ISSUE IN THE SUM OF FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS TO APPLY ON THE COSTS AND EXPENSES OF ACQUIRING AND CONSTRUCTING SAID SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM AND FACILITIES; PROVIDING FOR THE PROCEDURE OF SAID SPECIAL ELECTION; THE PREPARATION OF THE OFFICIAL BALLOTS THEREOF; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Brookings, Oregon, has declared its opinion to be that it is necessary and essential to relieve unsanitary conditions by the construction of a sanitary sewer system, consisting of sewer mains and laterals, disposal plant, pumping stations and pressure lines, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the acquiring, constructing and method of payment of said sanitary sewer system and its facilities be referred to a vote of the qualified electors of the City of Brookings, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has caused to be prepared plans, specifications and estimates of costs of such proposed facilities to be voted upon and that said plans, specifications and estimates of costs have been, and now are, on file in the

Office of the City Recorder in the City Hall and which may be examined by any qualified elector of the City of Brookings, Oregon.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BROOKINGS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Submission of proposition. The proposition set forth in section 2 of this ordinance shall be submitted in the manner prescribed in this ordinance to the legal voters of the City of Brookings, Oregon, at a special city election to be held on January 20, 1956.

Section 2. Ballot title. At the special election to be held on January 20, 1956, there shall be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Brookings, Oregon, for their approval or rejection, the following proposition:

"Shall a sanitary sewer system and facilities be acquired and constructed within the corporate limits of the City of Brookings, Oregon, as said sewer system and facilities are set forth in plans, specifications, and estimates of cost thereof as the same are on file in the Office of the City Recorder?"

"Shall general obligation bonds in the sum of Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars be issued by the City of Brookings, Oregon to apply on the costs and expenses of the acquiring and constructing said sanitary sewer system and facilities?"

Section 3. Polling places. (1) the regular polling places designated by the County Court of Curry County Oregon, in the voting precincts in the City of Brookings hereby are designated as the polling places for the city tax base election. (2) the poll books adopted by the County Court for state-wide elections for the voting precincts in the city of Brookings hereby are adopted as the poll books for said voting precincts at said special election. (3) There is hereby named and appointed as the judges and clerks of the said special election and to act in said offices at said voting precincts as follows:

Precinct No. 1.

Judges: Russell Jenkins, Cladys Kanick, Ethel Molino

Clerks: Dorothy Kilpatrick, Matilda Pate, Marjorie E. Moore

Precinct No. 2.

Judges: Gladys L. Brainard, Verna Mendenhall, Elsa Ravekes

Clerks: Art Bollinger, Vera Whillock, Clarice Crook

(4) The aforesaid named and appointed judges and clerks shall hold their respective offices as of the aforesaid date of said special election.

(5) The polls for said special election shall be open in each of the voting precincts at and during the same hours and said polls shall be opened at 8:00 a.m. and thereafter at all times continue to be open until closed at 8:00 p.m., on the date of said special election.

Section 4. Publication notice form. Notice of the special election provided to be held on January 20, 1956, shall be given not earlier than twenty (20) days and not later than ten (10) days before the election, said notice shall issue under the seal of the city and the notice of the city tax base election shall (a) be published in two (2) consecutive issues of the Brookings Harbor Pilot, a newspaper of general circulation in the city of Brookings, Oregon and (b) posted in five (5) public places in the city of Brookings, Oregon including the city hall. The notice published in the newspaper and posted in five (5) public places shall be in the following form:

Section 5. Posting of election notices. The City Recorder shall advertise and post or cause to be posted the notices required by section 4 of this ordinance. The notices of the special election required to be given by section 4 of this ordinance shall constitute the only notice necessary and all ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith shall not apply to the notices required to be given of the said special election. It shall be unnecessary for either the City of Brookings or any officials thereof to furnish the legal voters at the city tax base election pamphlets containing (a) the text of the propositions to be voted upon or (b) arguments in support of or in opposition to the propositions.

Section 6. Form of printed ballots. The following is the number and form in which the question shall be printed on the official ballots:

Section 7. Printing and distribution of official ballots. The City Recorder shall provide for the printing of the official ballot provided for in Section 6 of this ordinance and provide for the proper distribution thereof and shall provide and furnish to the polling places and judges and clerks of election, as said polling places and judges and clerks are set forth and named in section 4 of this ordinance, all necessary materials as the same may be required in said polling places and by said judges and clerks and so be necessary in the holding of this special city election.
