

ORDINANCE NO. 60-O-149

AN ORDINANCE SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, OREGON, AT THE SPECIAL CITY ELECTION HERETOFORE CALLED FOR JUNE 21, 1960, THE PROPOSITION THAT THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, THROUGH ITS COUNCIL, BE AUTHORIZED TO LEVY A SERIAL TAX OF \$7,000.00 ANNUALLY FOR FIVE YEARS, BEGINNING WITH THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 1960 TO JUNE 30, 1961, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF A FIRE ENGINE, HOSE AND OTHER FIRE FIGHTING EQUIPMENT FOR THE CITY, WHICH SERIAL TAX LEVY WILL BE OUTSIDE OF THE LIMITATION ON TAXATION AS SET FORTH IN SECTION 11 OF ARTICLE XI OF THE CONSTITUTION OF OREGON AND ANY CHARTER LIMITATIONS OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
