

ORDINANCE NO. 64-O-179

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, CURRY COUNTY, OREGON, ON THE OCTOBER 14, 1964 SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF SAID CITY AT SAID SPECIAL ELECTION A PROPOSED CITY CHARTER AMENDMENT BY ADDING THERETO A NEW CHAPTER TO BE KNOWN AS CHAPTER XII AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF NOT TO EXCEED \$1,300,000 IN BOND OF SAID CITY TO PROVIDE FUNDS WITH WHICH TO PROVIDE, BUY, CONSTRUCT, EQUIP AND MAINTAIN A MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEM FOR THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, AND ANY COMBINATION OF SUCH PURPOSES, PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST OF SAID BONDS FROM TAXES AND WATER REVENUES, AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO SECURE FEDERAL AID, LOANS OR GRANTS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, PROVIDING DEBT LIMITATIONS OF THE CITY CHARTER SHALL NOT APPLY TO SAID BONDS AND PROVIDING FOR THE OPERATION, MAINTENANCE AND MANAGEMENT OF SUCH MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
