

ORDINANCE NO. 66-O-187

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, CURRY COUNTY, OREGON, ON THE NOVEMBER 8, 1966 SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF SAID CITY A PROPOSED CITY CHARTER AMENDMENT BY ADDING THERETO A NEW CHAPTER TO BE KNOWN AS CHAPTER XIII, AUTHORIZING THE COUNCIL OF SAID CITY TO ISSUE BONDS OF THE CITY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$32,000 TO PROVIDE FUNDS WITH WHICH TO RECONSTRUCT THE MEMORY LANE SANITARY SEWER LIFT STATION AND TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT THEREFORE AND MAKE OTHER SANITARY SEWER IMPROVEMENTS, PROVIDING THAT THE DEBT LIMITATION OF THE CITY CHARTER SHALL NOT APPLY TO SAID BONDS, PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF SAID BONDS, BOTH AS TO PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST, FROM TAXES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
