ORDINANCE NO. 68-O-200

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE PUBLIC BY REQUIRING COMPLIANCE WITH STATE PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION AND STATE BOARD OF HEALTH REGULATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. [Adopted July 9, 1968]

- Section 1. Compliance with Oregon State Board of Health and Public Utility Commission Required.  
Section 2. Penalties.  
Section 3. [Emergency clause.]

The city of Brookings ordains as follows:

Section 1. Compliance with Oregon State Board of Health and Public Utility Commission Required. No person, firm, or corporation, nor any employee, agent, or representative of any such person, firm, or corporation shall be given a permit to maintain or construct any electric lines, telephone lines, sewer lines, or water lines that are subject to regulations by the Oregon State Board of Health or the Public Utilities Commission without first obeying and complying with all applicable rules, regulations, and directives, and obtaining approval of said Oregon State Board of Health and Public Utilities Commission.

Section 2. Penalties. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$500.00 for each day of such violation, or by imprisonment in the city jail for a period not to exceed six (6) months, or by both.

Section 3. [Emergency clause.]
