

**ORDINANCE NO. 73-O-234**

**AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO THE GENERAL TELEPHONE COMPANY OF THE NORTHWEST, INC., A CORPORATION, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, THE RIGHT TO PLACE, ERECT, AND MAINTAIN POLES, WIRES, AND OTHER APPLIANCES AND CONDUCTORS; AND TO LAY UNDERGROUND CONDUCTORS FOR THE TRANSMISSION OF ELECTRICITY FOR TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH PURPOSES IN, UPON, AND UNDER THE STREETS, ALLEYS, AVENUES, THOROUGHFARES, AND PUBLIC HIGHWAYS IN THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, STATE OF OREGON; AND TO EXERCISE THE PRIVILEGE OF OPERATING TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH INSTRUMENTS; AND OF DOING A TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH BUSINESS WITHIN SAID CITY.
