AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 61-O-157 OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS PERTAINING TO TRAFFIC AND PARKING CODE FOR MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. [Effective June 19, 1979]

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Brookings, as follows:

Section 1. Adoption of Oregon Revised Statutes Chapters 484 and 487.
Section 1 of Ordinance No. 61-O-157 of the City of Brookings is amended to include the adoption by reference and making a part thereof Chapters 484 and 487, of Oregon Revised Statutes, as they appear on the date of adoption of this Ordinance. Any amendment or revision of said chapters, Section or part by the Oregon Legislature, shall be adopted by reference and made a part of this Ordinance at the affective date of said amendment or revision in the Oregon Revised Statutes, and shall have full force and affect as a part of this Ordinance, without further action by the City Council. Except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning, the definitions outlined in Chapters 484 and 467 shall apply to all sections of Ordinance No. 61-O-157. All parts of Section 1 inconsistent with this amendment are hereby repealed.

Section 2. Severability clause. If any provision, or provisions of this Ordinance shall be declared void and/or unconstitutional, it is hereby provided that all other parts of the same which are not expressly held to be void and/ or unconstitutional, shall be and continue in full force and affect.
