**THE CITY OF BROOKINGS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Waiver of election.** That the proposal for annexation of the real property described in Exhibit -A- and shown in Exhibit "B" attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, heretofore filed with the City Council of the City of Brookings by George C. and Careen C. Laughingly as owners be heard and determined without election thereon within the City of Brookings as provided by Chapter 222 of the Oregon Revised Statutes.

**Section 2. Time and date of public hearing.** That said proposal shall come on for public hearing by the City Council of the City of Brookings at the hour of 7:00 p.m. on the 13th day of August, 1985, at the City Hall of the City of Brookings, Oregon, at which time the registered voters of the City may appear and be heard on the question of annexation.

**Section 3. Public hearing notices.** That the City Recorder be and hereby is directed to give notice of such hearing by publishing the same once each week for two successive weeks prior to the day of the hearing in the Curry Coastal Pilot, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Brookings, Curry County, Oregon, and to posting notices of the hearing in four (4) public places in the City for a like period, all of such notices to be substantially in the form attached hereto, marked Exhibit "C" and by this reference made a part hereof.
