Section 1. Withdrawal from Dawson Rural Fire Protection District.

Section 2. Uncollected taxes to be delivered to City.

WHEREAS, George C. & Corrine C. Langley have heretofore filed with the City Recorder of the City of Brookings, their proposal for the annexation of the real property described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, to the City of Brookings; and,

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 85-R-373, enacted on the 13th day of August, 1985, the City Council elected to hold a hearing on the question of the withdrawal of the aforementioned property from the Dawson Rural Fire Protection District; and,

WHEREAS, notice of such hearing was duly published; and,

WHEREAS, said hearing has duly been held; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the aforementioned property should be withdrawn from the Dawson Rural Fire Protection District, upon annexation to the City of Brookings;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Brookings ordains as follows:

Section 1. Withdrawal from Dawson Rural Fire Protection District. That the property described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto is hereby withdrawn from the Dawson Rural Fire Protection District upon the annexation of the aforementioned property to the City of Brookings; and,

Section 2. Uncollected taxes to be delivered to City. That all uncollected taxes therefor levied by such District shall become the property of the City of Brookings and be delivered to the City upon collection.
