

ORDINANCE NO. 90-O-383.A

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 84-O-383, SECTION 6,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

The city of Brookings ordains as follows:

**Section 1. Amendment to Ordinance No. 84-O-383,
Section 6. Ordinance No. 84-O-383, Section 6 shall be repealed in its
entirety and shall be replaced with the following language:**

**Section 6. Franchise fee. The permission and
authority herein granted are upon the express condition
that the company, as consideration therefor, and as
compensation for the use herein granted of city streets,
alleys, viaducts, elevated roadways, bridges, and other
public ways, shall pay into the municipal treasury a sum
equal to **3.3%** of its gross local exchange service receipts
and operating revenues which are hereby defined to mean
such local service revenues as defined by the Federal
Communications Commission in its rules and regulations
under operating revenue accounts and gross revenues as
defined within the Oregon Administrative Rules relating to
city fees, taxes and other assessments, for services
rendered resulting from the use of its plant and properties
within the city for the transmission of sound and signals
or other means of communications by means of
electricity.**

Section 2. Emergency clause. The earliest imposition of the provisions of this ordinance is necessary to derive required revenues for the city, and to preserve the peace, health and safety of the public. Accordingly, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage by the city council and approval by the mayor.
