

ORDINANCE NO. 90-O-387.A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 84-O-387, SECTIONS 6, 8 AND 10 OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS.

Sections:

- Section 1. Amendment to Section 6.
- Section 2. Amendment to Section 8 Subsection B.
- Section 3. Amendment to Section 10.

The city of Brookings ordains as follows:

Section 1. Amendment to Section 6. Section 6 of Ordinance No. 84-O-387 shall be repealed in its entirety and shall be replaced with the following language:

Section 6. Operator requirements.

- A. No person shall operate a taxicab for hire within the city of Brookings without having first obtained a cab drivers permit.
- B. Application for such permit may be made by the payment of a fee to the City of Brookings in the sum of (\$20.00) and shall set forth the name, address, date of birth, and Oregon Driver's License Number of the applicant. The applicant shall provide a 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" photograph to be attached to the cab driver's permit. The applicant shall be fingerprinted by the Brookings Police Department. A permit may be issued by the city of Brookings if the applicant:
 - 1. Is 21 years of age or older; and
 - 2. Possesses a valid State of Oregon motor vehicle chauffeurs operator's license; and
 - 3. Has not been convicted of a felony or a crime involving dishonesty or moral turpitude at any time within five years preceding the date of application; and
 - 4. Has not been declared a habitual traffic offender or had his/her license to operate a motor vehicle suspended by any state within 10 years preceding the date of application.

C. The City Manager may revoke the permit of a cab driver who is convicted of possession of an open container of alcohol, possession, manufacture or delivery of a controlled substance, (not including the delivery of medically prescribed drugs), or a major traffic offense, all as defined in Oregon Revised Statutes, committed while in the course of his/her employment.

D. It shall be unlawful for any operator of a taxicab, while on duty, to drink any intoxicating liquor or use any controlled substance, to use any obscene language, to shout or to call to prospective passengers, or to disobey any traffic rules or regulations established by statute or ordinance.

E. The cab driver's permit shall be displayed in a prominent place in the taxicab at all time when in service. A cab driver's permit is not transferable.

Section 2. Amendment to Section 8 Subsection B. Section 8, Subsection B of Ordinance No. 84-O-387 shall be repealed in its entirety and shall be replaced with the following language:

Section 8. License and equipment requirements.

B. No taxicab shall be operated unless it is equipped with a rate or fare schedule showing the amount to be charged on each trip, which amount shall be in figures visible to the passenger. Upon paying his fare each passenger shall be given a receipt showing the amount so paid and the name of the company or person operating the cab, together with the number of the cab if such company or person operates more than one taxicab in the city.

Section 3. Amendment to Section 10. Section 10 of Ordinance No. 84-O-387 shall be repealed in its entirety and shall be replaced with the following language:

Section 10. Rate and fares. Each operator of each taxicab licensed to be operated under the provisions of this ordinance shall not make charges to his passengers which would exceed the rates or fares as set by the common council of the city of Brookings upon its motions enacting such rate and fee schedule from time to time. In no event shall any extra charges be made for baggage or parcels the size of which permits them to be carried in the cab by the passenger. A map showing rates or fares shall be displayed in a prominent place in the taxicab at all times when in service. The map shall be of sufficient size that passengers can clearly distinguish the rate or fare zones.
