AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 86-O-408 ENACTED NOVEMBER 17, 1986, AND ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING PORTIONS OF THE OREGON CRIMINAL CODE, THE OREGON LIQUOR CONTROL LAWS, THE OREGON CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES LAWS, THE OREGON MOTOR VEHICLE CODE; AMENDING ORDINANCES NO. 81-O-349 AND 81-O-350; AND, FURTHER AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 51-O-013", BY AMENDING SECTION 1.

Section 1. **Amendment to Section 1.**

The City of Brookings ordains as follows:

Section 1. **Amendment to Section 1.** Section 1 of Ordinance No. 86-O-408 enacted November 17, 1986, is hereby amended to read in full as follows:

Section 1. The following enumerated portions of the Oregon Revised Statutes concerning the Oregon Criminal Code, the liquor control laws, the controlled substance laws, the Motor Vehicle Codes, together with all acts and amendments thereto now existing or made a part hereof, are hereby adopted by reference and made a part of this Ordinance, as if fully set forth herein, to be enforceable and enforced by the City of Brookings within the corporate limits of the City, as follows:

Oregon Revised Statutes Chapters 161 through 167, 471, 475 and 801 through 823 specifying violations, infractions, misdemeanors and other such offenses so specified, set forth and defined therein.

Section 2. **Emergency clause.** For the purposes of maintaining consistency with state law and for the consistent, uniform and expeditious prosecution of criminal offenses committed within the City of Brookings, the enactment of this Ordinance affects the peace, health and welfare of the City and will be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
