

ORDINANCE NO. 91-O-430.A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 88-0-430, ENACTED DECEMBER 15, 1988, AND ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING USE AND DISCHARGE OF WASTES INTO THE PUBLIC SEWERS OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, OREGON; PROMULGATING THE REGULATIONS; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES", BY THE ADDITION OF SECTION 5 WITHIN ARTICLE II; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT BY ADDITION OF ARTICLE II,

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.

The City of Brookings ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. ADDITION OF SECTION 5, ARTICLE II. Ordinance No. 88-0-430 enacted December 15, 1988, is hereby amended by the addition of Section 5 to Article II which shall read in full as follows:

SECTION 5. APPROVAL OF REQUESTS FOR CONNECTION TO THE CITY'S SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM. From and after the date of the enactment of Ordinance No. 91-0-471, requests for approval for connection to the City's sewage disposal system shall be made only in accordance with the terms and provisions of Ordinance No. 91-0-471. The provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect and shall at all times be applicable to govern the regulation of the use and discharge of wastes into the public sewers of the City of Brookings.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. The matters contained herein substantially affect the peace, health, safety and welfare of the people of the City of Brookings and, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
