

ORDINANCE NO. 94-0-505

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING USE OF CITY OWNED PUBLIC PARKS AND CITY OWNED PUBLIC RECREATIONAL AREAS IN THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Sections:

- Section 1. City owned public parks and city owned public recreational areas hours.
- Section 2. Exceptions.
- Section 3. Penalties.
- Section 4. Emergency clause.

The City of Brookings ordains as follows:

Section 1. City owned public parks and city owned public recreational areas hours. Except as provided in Section 2 of this ordinance, all city owned public parks and city owned public recreational areas located within the City of Brookings shall be open for use by the public from one-half (1/2) hour prior to sunrise to one-half (1/2) hour past sunset.

Section 2. Exceptions. The City Manager may, upon prior application, permit use of a city owned public park or city owned public recreational area at times other than the times that the premises are open for use by the public.

Section 3. Penalties. No person or entity shall use a city owned public park or city owned public recreational area at times other than those specified in this Ordinance. Any person or entity who violates this ordinance, or any part thereof, shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not exceeding \$500.

Section 4. Emergency clause. It is hereby determined that it is in the best interest of the public peace, health, safety and welfare that immediate action be taken, and therefore an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately on its passage by the City Council and signing by the Mayor.
