PUBLIC NOTICE NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING BEFORE THE BROOKINGS PLANNING COMMISSION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held before the Brookings Planning Commission on Tuesday, October 6, 2009, at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of Brookings City Hall, 898 Elk Drive, Brookings.

In the matter of File No. **CPZ-1-09** Applicant: Cury General Hospital, a request to change the zoning of two parcels from Multi-family Residential (R3) to General Commercial (C-3) located on Assessor's map 41-13-06AC tax lot 100 and Assessor's map 41-13-06AD tax lot 700. The criteria used to decide this matter is found in Chapter 17.140 Legislative Text Amendments and Quasi-Judicial Comprehensive Plan Map and/or Zone Changes, of the BMC. This is a quasi-judicial hearing and the Planning Commission will make a recommendation to City Council.

In the matter of File No. **LDC-13-09** Hazardous Building Site Protection/ Hillside Development Standards, a proposed amendment to Chapter 17.100 of the Brookings Municipal Code (BMC), City initiated. The criteria used to decide this matter is found in Chapter 17.140 Amendments, of the BMC. This is a legislative hearing and the Planning Commission will make a recommendation to City Council.

In the matter of File No. **LDC-15-09** Establishment of Zoning Districts & Zoning Map, a proposed amendment to Chapter 17.12 of the BMC, City initiated. The criteria used to decide this matter is found in Chapter 17.140 Amendments, of the BMC. This is a legislative hearing and the Planning Commission will make a recommendation to City Council.

The public is invited to attend and participate in this public hearing. All persons wishing to address this matter will have an opportunity to do so in person at the hearing or by submitting written evidence to the Planning Department at the address above. If you wish to attend the hearing, you will be asked to sign in and afforded 5 minutes to speak. Failure to raise an issue accompanied by statements or evidence sufficient to afford the Commission and parties an opportunity to respond to the issues precludes appeal to the Oregon Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA).

A copy of the application and all documents and evidence submitted on behalf of the applicant, in addition to the staff report prepared for this case will be available for public inspection, at no cost at the Brookings Planning Department, 898 Elk Drive Brookings, OR, 541-469-1135. Copies of any of these documents may be obtained at reasonable cost, seven days prior to the hearing.
